

TIPS FOR ENCOURAGING READING:

- Summer reading should be fun, not a chore!
- Let kids choose their own books to read.
- Don't worry about reading levels for leisure reading; reading below level increases fluency & builds confidence.
- Audiobooks & graphic novels are real books.
- Consider non-fiction & biographies, many readers prefer informational books over fiction.
- Illustrated books are for everyone!
- Encourage young readers to explore other genres, but don't force it or be dismissive of their preferred genre or format.
- Read together as well as giving them time to read or look at books alone.
- Provide quiet time & a cozy spot for reading.
- Let your kids see you reading, too!

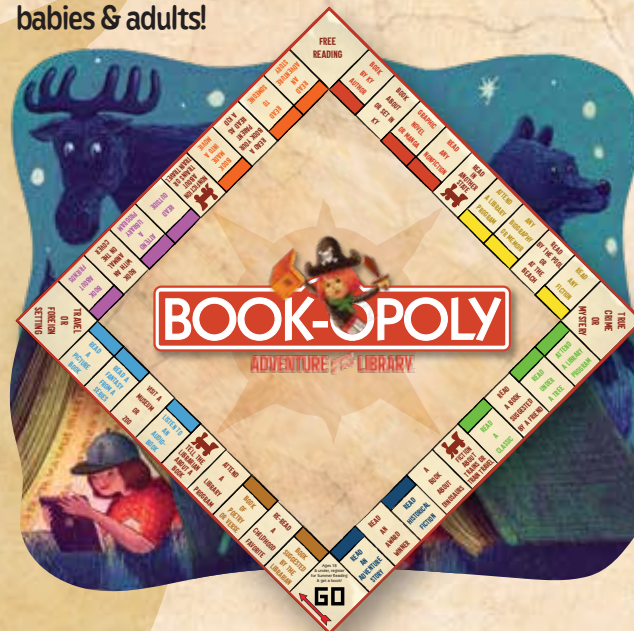

READING CHALLENGE

Our summer discovery program has two parts: the activities/events, and the 'Book-opoly' reading challenge. The reading challenge starts June 1st and runs through July 31st and is for all ages, including babies & adults!



'Book-opoly' is a fun way to encourage leisure reading, exploring new genres & authors, and attending library programs. Color in squares as you complete each activity, then turn it in at the end of the summer with at least 5 squares completed for a chance to win a \$25 gift card or prize. Children & teens also earn books for registering and upon completion. (All prizes must be claimed in person.) All reading counts: print books, e-books, audiobooks, graphic novels, magazines, etc., whether they are from the library or not. For kids who are not yet reading independently, count being read to, listening to audiobooks, or looking at picture books. (There is a separate 'Book-opoly' board for ages 5 and under.)
